It's hard to believe the summer is almost over, but, alas, it's true. Be sure to *call early* to schedule your closing in order to get a time convenient for you.

If you've noticed a problem with the pool that hasn't received proper attention, let us know now so we can address it before you put your pool to sleep for the winter.

Loop Loc safety Covers

Considering a new cover? Loop-Loc safety covers are available in the Ultra Loc solid safety or their new Loop Loc II Super Dense mesh material designed to block UV rays. The Ultra Loc cover blocks 100% of sunlight eliminating the need to open early and close late. It is 33% lighter than the typical solid safety cover and drains quickly through the invisible drainage panels. Best of all, they both come with a 12 year warranty! Safety covers have several advantages and may not be as expensive as you think! Insurance companies love them, openings and closings go faster which saves time and money, they are neater looking, and debris just blows right off.

FYI: Algae can not grow in water high in chlorine, temperatures below 50 degrees, without sunlight or without phosphates. Making conditions unfavorable to algae can help prevent the problem in the future.

Winter and Spring Duties

Homeowners should pump water off *solid* covers to prevent a safety hazard, damage to the cover or displacement of water in the pool. Pools with *mesh* covers may need additional chlorine added until water temperature is consistently less than 50 degrees.

- **Adjust water chemistry**
- **Lower the water level**
- **Fill water bags**
- **Have everything we need available**
- **Vacuum the pool**

FYI: We recommend that you NEVER add chemicals to your pool through the skimmer or pump baskets. Chlorine especially is very caustic to your equipment and can do costly damage to your system, especially heaters. Water washing back into the pool from the skimmer holding chlorine tabs can cause the liner to become brittle and discolored. This can force premature replacement of the liner. DE, used in filtration systems is not a chemical. DE can and should be added to the skimmer.

Note: In order to get a date for your closing that is convenient for you, CALL EARLY. The schedule fills *fast!*

FOR AN EASIER OPENING NEXT YEAR

- Vacuum pool prior to closing
- Clean DE or cartridge filters
- Keep leaves off cover throughout the winter
- Owners with older style mesh covers should check phosphate levels, open early and / or add liquid chlorine to the pool.
- Give pool an end of the season shock and balance water chemicals.
- Pump water from solid covers
